And ET, with her artistic zest, brought pumpkins to life with her carving skills, reminiscing joyously about the Halloweens of her childhood.













Celebrating Creativity: The Art of Pumpkin Carving



A Breath of Fresh Air at Trent Country Park


Pauline's Pastoral Adventure


The Power of Connection




Creative Spirits and Harmonious Melodies
