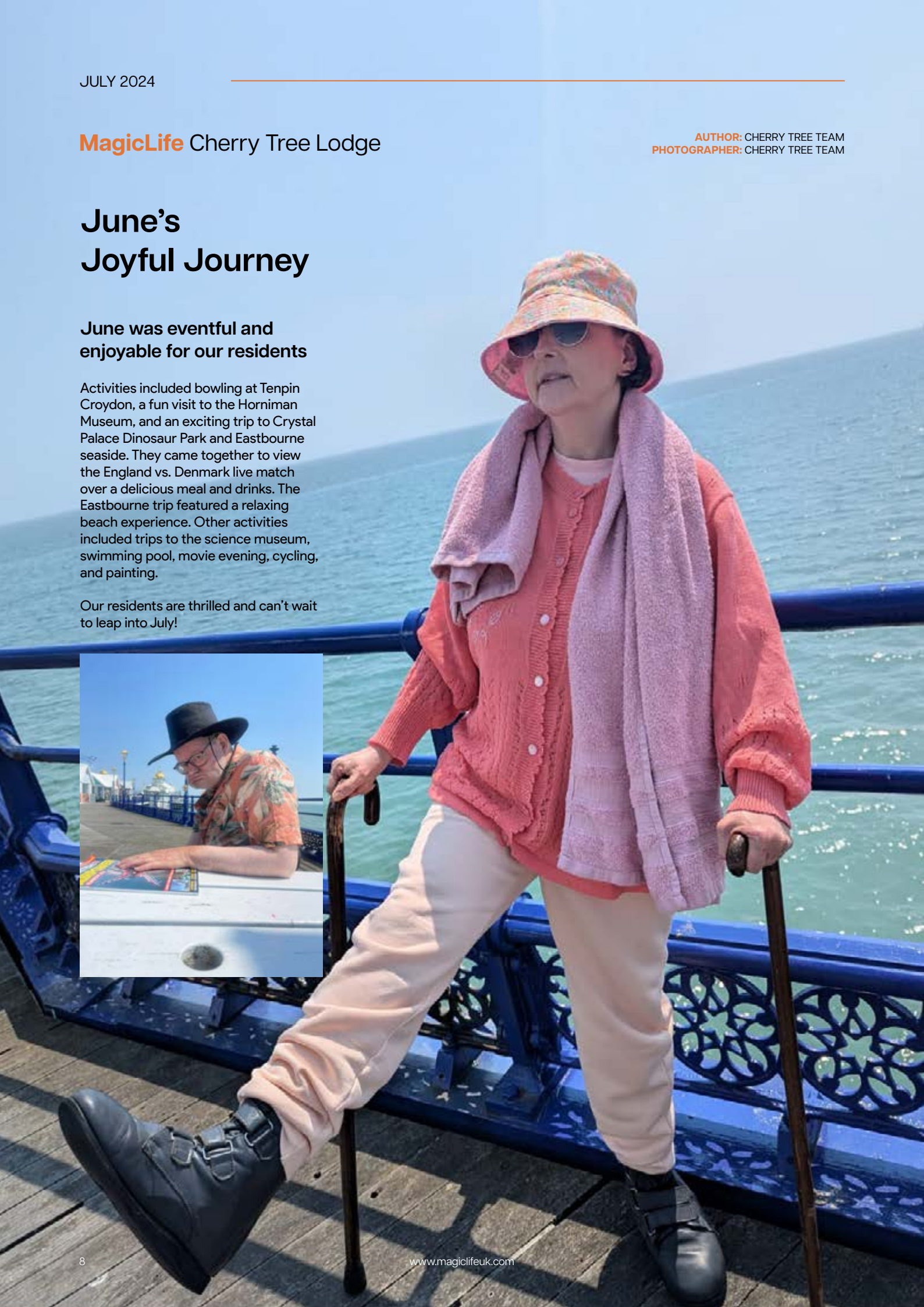

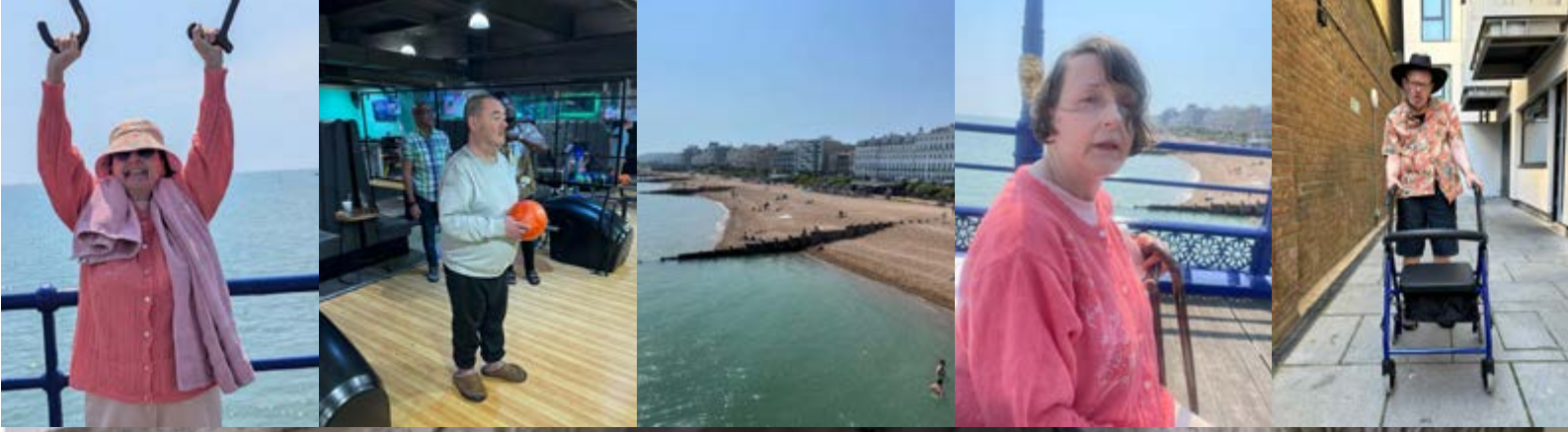
## June's Joyful Journey

Our residents are thrilled and can't wait to leap into July!



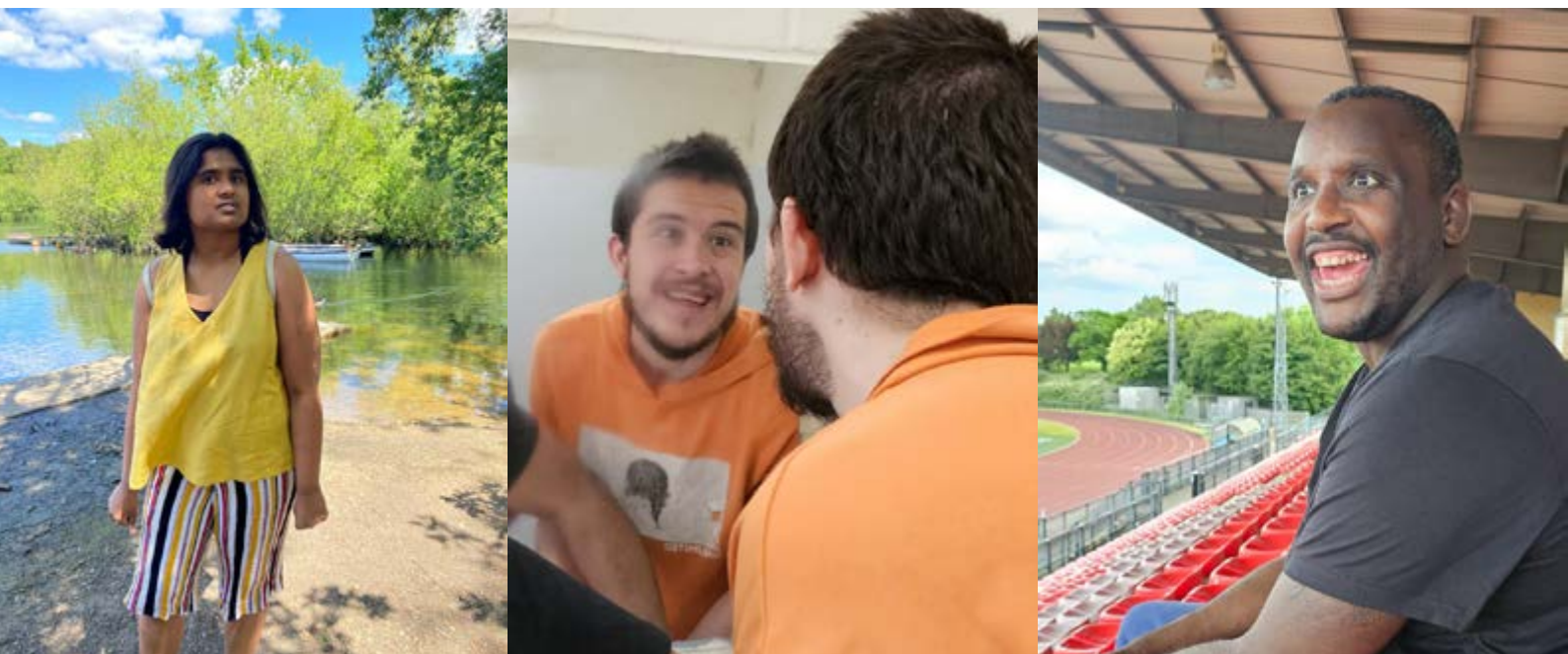

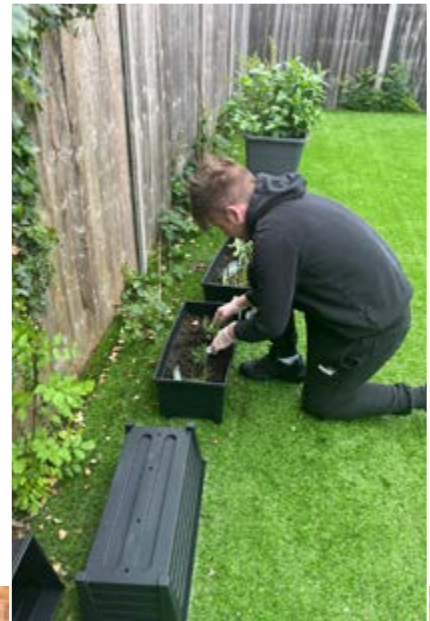

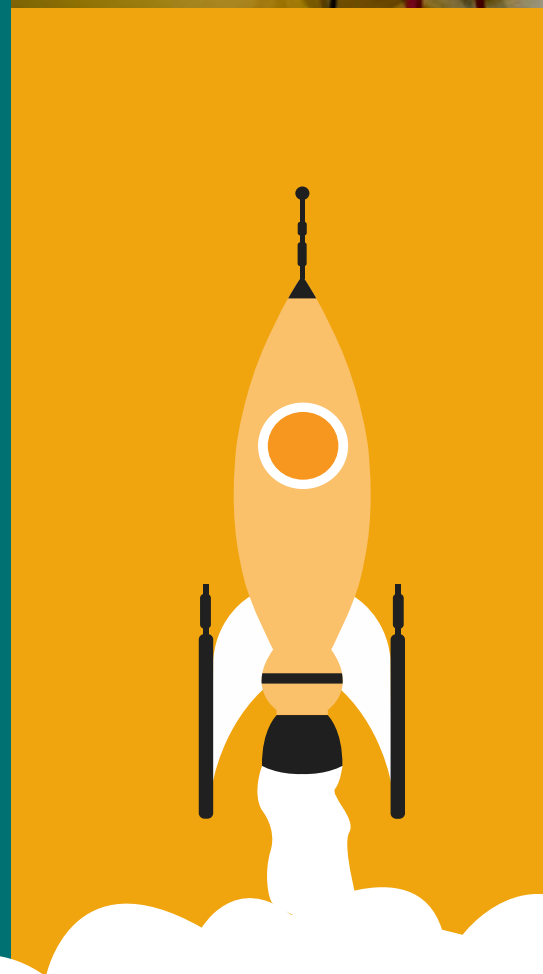
