Big Smiles and Bright Days Ahead

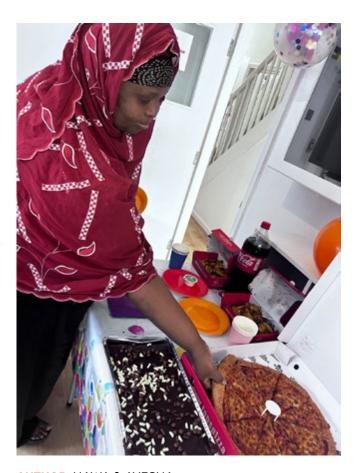
We're so proud of how beautifully KM has settled in, and we look forward to seeing her continue to thrive. This is just the beginning, and we're thrilled to be on this journey with her.

An Evening of Pure Joy

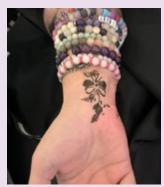

This July, we were thrilled to welcome Briannah Hamilton to Park Lodge. From the moment she arrived, Briannah's

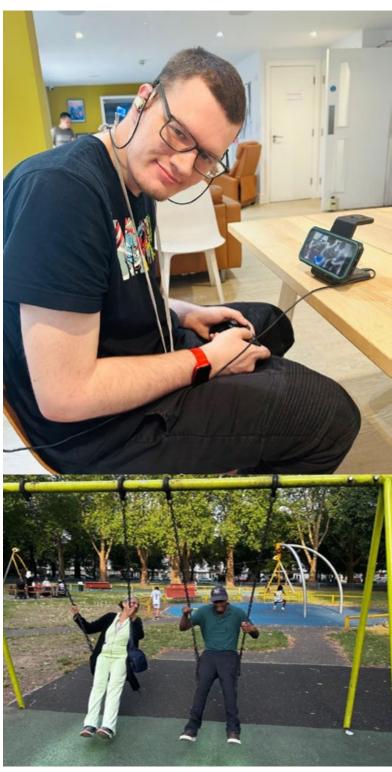
warmth and dedication have made a real impact. Whether lending a helping hand during activities or sharing a kind word in passing, she's already become a cherished member of our community.
